

Terms & Conditions - Good2bewet Scuba Diving Club

A) General Terms of Membership

1. Membership of Good 2 Be Wet Scuba Dive Club is open to qualified divers from any agency.
2. Membership is free. Funds are raised by applying surcharges of £5 to Shore Dives and organised trips. (Exception is quarries where you pay to get in and dive, and they have their own o2 Kit). The surcharge is to cover admin and the up keep of the clubs o2 kit
3. The club reserves the right to restrict the membership for the benefit and good of the club. The club also reserve the right to remove membership from any person(s) that are acting in a way that is deemed incompatible to the overall aim of the club and its members or if anyone should breach terms and conditions of the membership.
4. Members supplying contact information imply consent for the club to use to contact members about upcoming events and changes in club format. This information will not be passed to any third party. Members may ask for this information to be removed at any time by contacting any committee member.
5. Your use of the Facebook Closed Group, and logging on to the website confirm that you will abide by these terms and conditions. From time to time members will be notified to read any ammendments to these Ts & Cs.
6. All members are responsible for their own personal safety and equipment at all times.

B) Benefits of the Club

1. Provide Closed FaceBook group for members to discuss dive topics and to arrange events.
2. Provide o2 Kit for any Emergency Oxygen Provider Qualified members to use at club events. Other members may also hold the o2 Kit if appropriately qualified and agreed by the committee.
3. Provide website [www.good2bewet.co.uk](http://www.good2bewet.co.uk) for diving resources and account details
5. Regular Club Socials at various locations usually on the First Wednesday of the month.
6. Members may participate in a Trip Saving scheme

C) Structure of Club (Committee and their roles)

1. The club is managed by an elected committee.
2. The elected committee is voted in at the April Club Social where a breif AGM will also be held.
3. The roles in the committee are
  - a) Chair Person - Prepares agenda, Arranges regular monthly meetings, chairs meeting to keep to agenda.
  - b) Secretary - takes notes of the meetings, publishes notes to facebook and the website.
  - c) Treasurer - Looking after club finances, provide regular updates to the committee and sets budgets.
  - d) Assistants - help promote club, advertise and other duties.
- \* All posts in the committee demand members to be flexible and assist with trips / events and other projects.
5. Members may submit items to be included on the agenda by sending an email to [staff@good2bewet.co.uk](mailto:staff@good2bewet.co.uk) or by submitting on the web site.
6. Committee meetings are generally held one week ahead of the Club Social. Day

and venue may vary, to accommodate members shift patterns. Committee meeting are not held every month they are held as and when needed. The committee will aim to meet at least once every 3 months.

D) Events

1. Any member can organise group events. Help will be given by the committee to collect in monies and to pay monies out and promotion of the event.
2. Events will be posted on the closed FaceBook group and [www.good2bewet.co.uk](http://www.good2bewet.co.uk)
3. Members are only booked on trips requiring money to be paid when a NON REFUNDABLE deposit is made.
4. Once a deposit is taken the member is then liable for full amount unless a replacement can be found by the member to take their place.
5. Full payment must be made by the Due date.
6. If a dive is cancelled by the club all monies will be repaid in full.
7. If the date of a dive is changed members will be given the opportunity to cancel their place without liability and full monies refunded.
8. If a diver fails to turn up for a dive no refunds will be paid.
9. The club cannot be held responsible for the cancellation of events or dives that our outside of our control. Every attempt will be made to contact club members to inform them of any cancellation. However, this is not always possible and no responsibility can be attributed to the club should the club member incur any additional costs due to cancellations.
10. Members may be required to sign a 'Boat/Liability Release Form' where 3rd party operators request one.
11. All club members are responsible for their own equipment and dive planning. All club members need to ensure that they stay within their personal limitations or within their level of certification and that they have the correct equipment to dive with and that their equipment is in good working order. All diving is your personal responsibility, and you dive at your own risk. You should ensure you are medically fit for diving.
12. All divers participating in any club diving activities must own and be able to competently use their own Delayed Surface Marker Buoy (DSMB) and reel.
13. In the unlikely event of any accident, loss, damage or injury caused to club members whether self-inflicted or by any other party neither the club, or any dive team member representing the club will be held responsible.
14. Qualified Children are permitted to dive with the club but a Parent / Guardian must be in attendance and supervise the child at all times.

E) FaceBook 'Closed Group' and website

1. Members on Joining will be invited to a Facebook Group called Good 2 be Wet.
2. Members on Joining will be given login details for the Members section of [www.good2bewet.co.uk](http://www.good2bewet.co.uk)
3. Members will not share these details with any one else.
4. The club does not warrant any post on the facebook page.
5. If a post is made which is considered inappropriate this will be removed and the member dealt with. If such a post raises concerns please email [staff@good2bewet.co.uk](mailto:staff@good2bewet.co.uk) and this will be looked into.

F) o2 Kit

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1. The club in association with Craig Moss will seek to obtain an o2 Kit. Craig Moss will retain atleast 10% of the o2 Kit. This deal is to help finance obtianing the o2 Kit quickly. The club will endeavour to buy back upto 90% share of the kit as soon as it is able to.
2. o2 Kit will remain in the custody of committee members, a qualified o2 member, or a member approved by the committe in attendance at a club event.
3. To prevent double booking of the o2 Kit from training sessions and Club trips, training sessions will be placed as an event on face book, on the calendar and on the Group page.

G) Trip Saving Sceme

Terms and conditions

1. Monies paid in will NOT attract interest.
2. Requests to move monies to a trip should be advised by email to [trips@good2bewet.co.uk](mailto:trips@good2bewet.co.uk) a confirmation email will be returned showing a current statement of monies in your account.
3. Statements may be ordered by email to [trips@good2bewet.co.uk](mailto:trips@good2bewet.co.uk)
4. If a member requests for money to be transferred to a trip from the saving account, then the member acknowledges that the money is then subject to the clubs terms and conditions regarding trips.
5. In the event that there is a refund from a trip, money will be transferred back into the saving account, and a statement will be sent to the recipient.
6. Monies from the saving account can be refunded to a member up on email request. Member should allow 14 days for this to be returned, however we will make every effort to return this faster with a new statement.
